



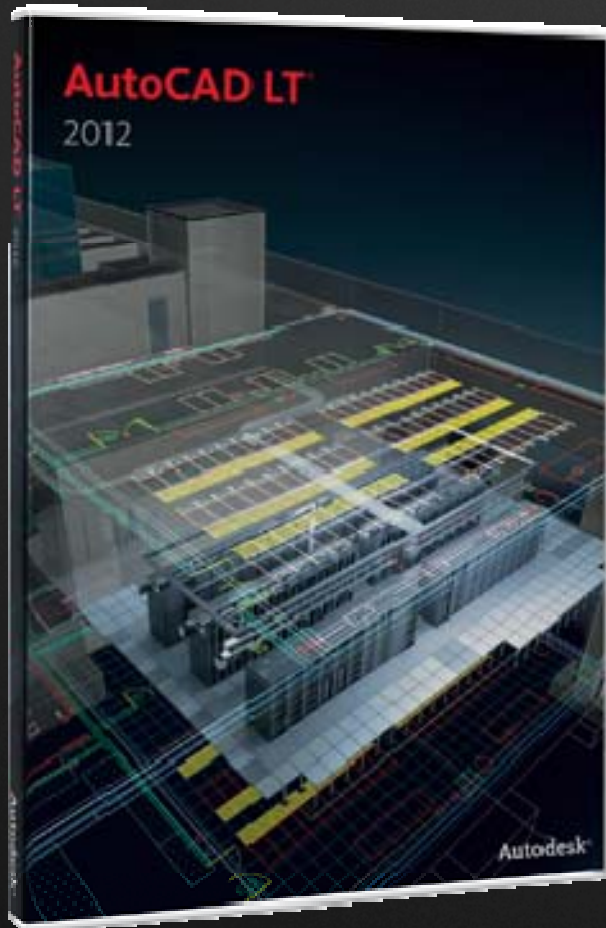

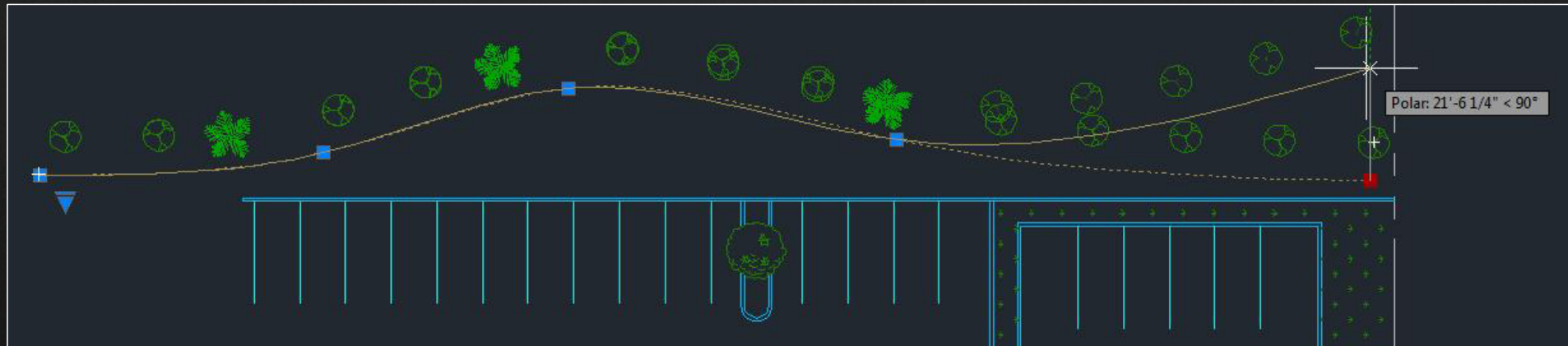

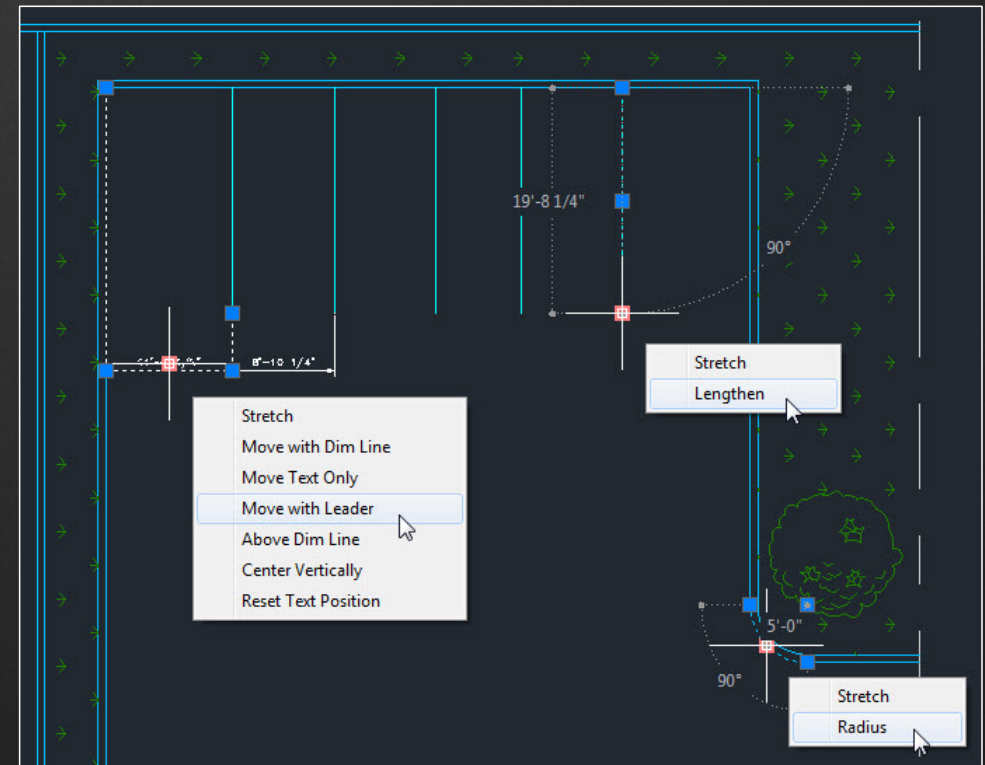
Associative Array

- Array objects along a specified path, rather than being restricted to rectangular or polar options.



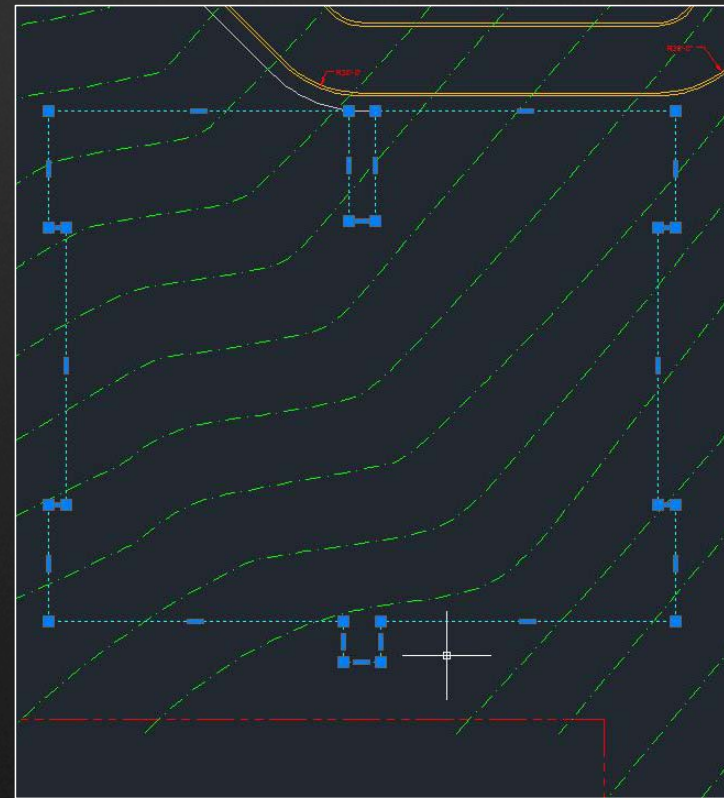
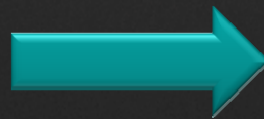
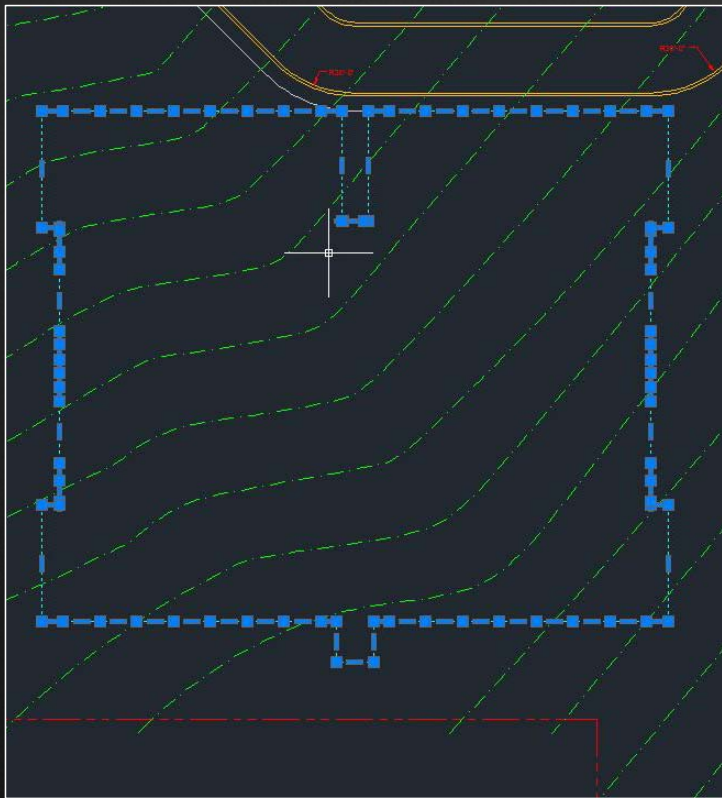
Multifunctional Grips

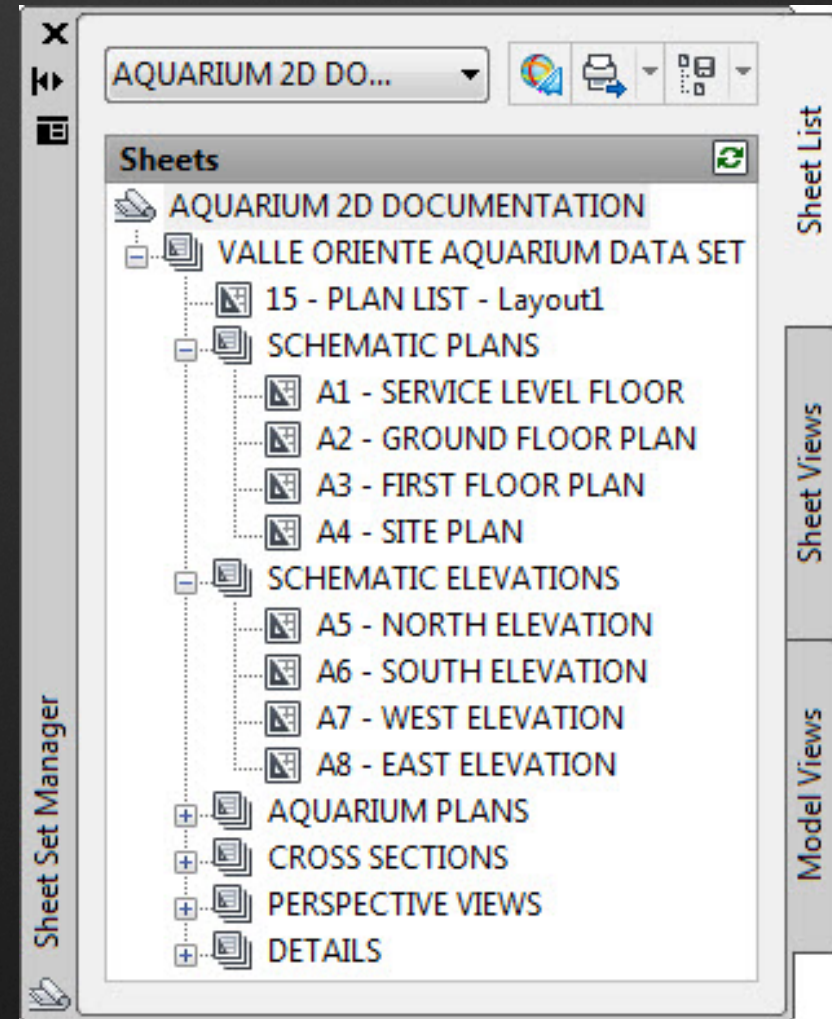
Delete Duplicate Objects

Clean up drawings by automatically removing redundant or unneeded geometry.



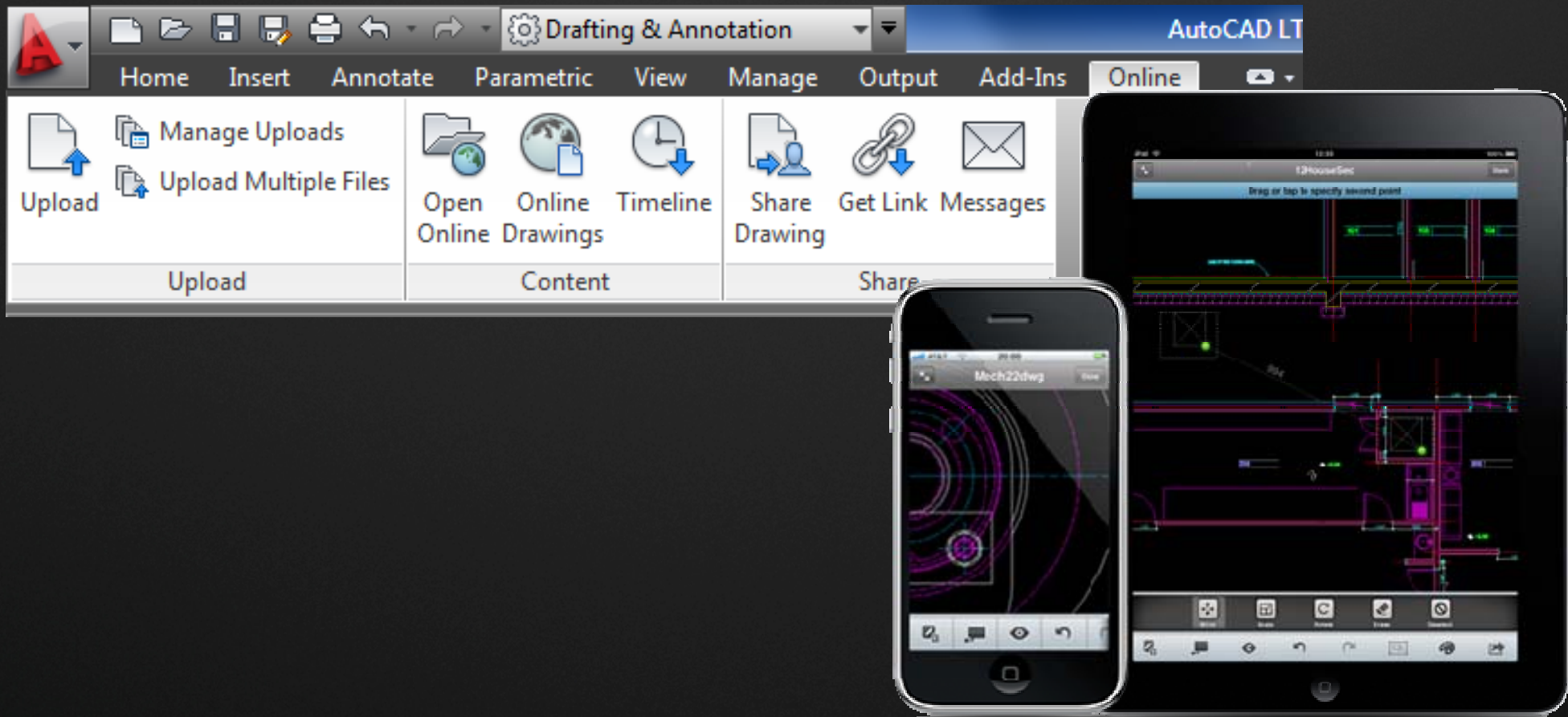
Sheet Set Manager

The drawing organization and collaboration tool previously offered only in AutoCAD® software is now supported in AutoCAD LT, facilitating improved collaboration.



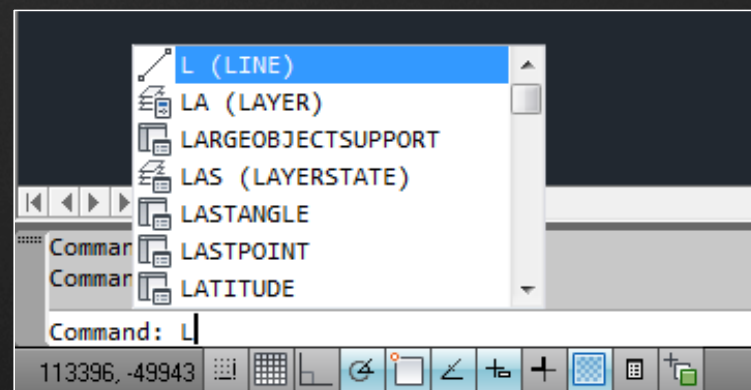
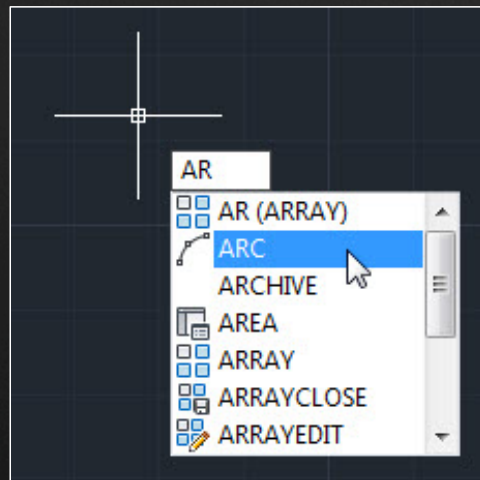
AutoCAD WS

The browser-based and mobile app versions of AutoCAD® WS software provide file storage, viewing, and better collaboration using DWG™ files.



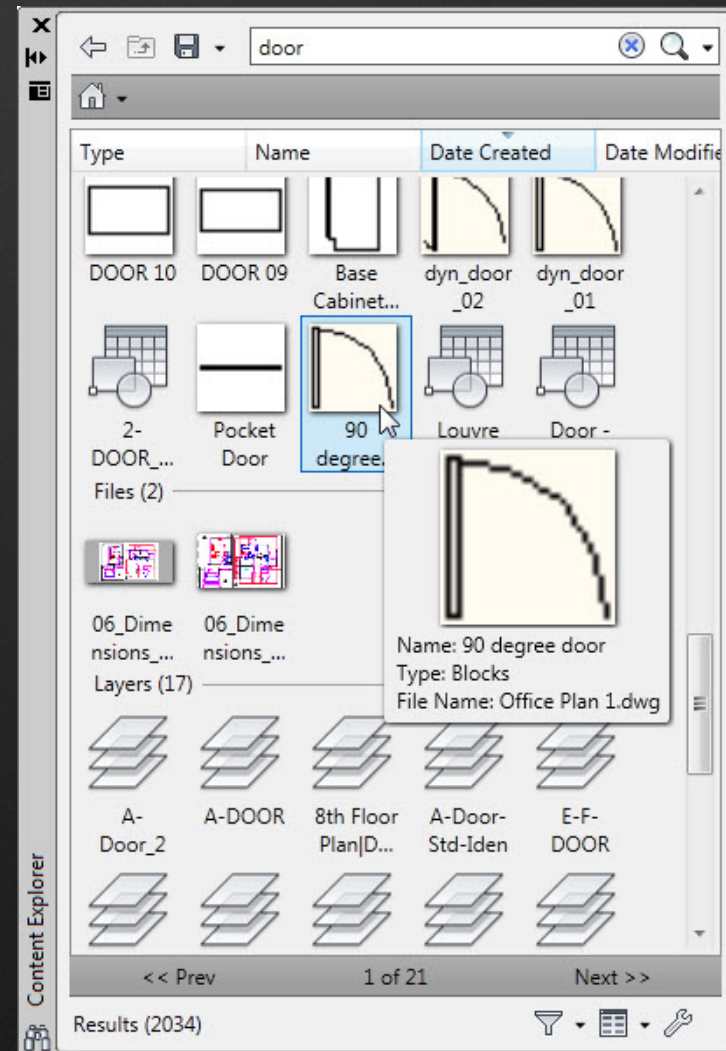
Command Line Enhancements

Suggestions for command names and aliases are displayed as the user types. The command history is distinguished from the active command line with a gray background color.



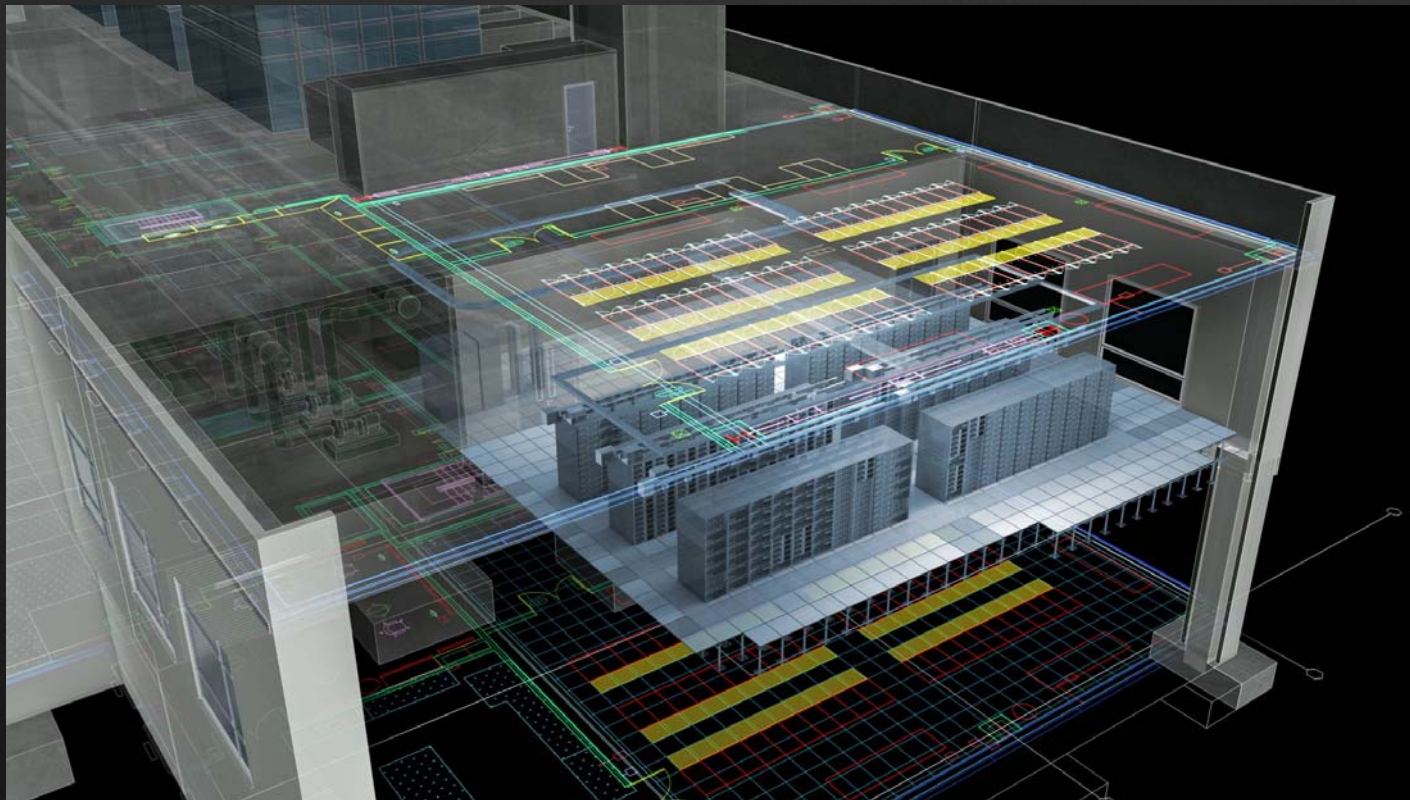
Autodesk Content Explorer

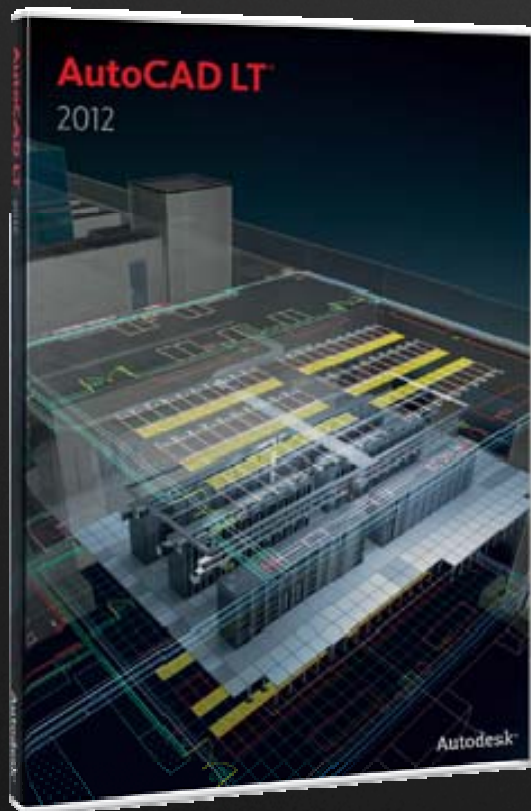
